

TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1.) The 2023 Give 'N Go Tournament committee has the final say in all decisions/issues. The committee members are Darrin Harrold, Alison Rattai, Michael Klacmera, and Jack Zayat.
- 2.) Only those players who are properly registered may participate in the 2023 Give 'N Go Tournament. Dressing and/or using ineligible players shall result in forfeiture of the game (unless prior permission is granted by the tournament committee).
- 3.) Players, coaches and fans must show respect for the game, their opponents, the officials, and each other. Those displaying unruly conduct or causing altercations before, during, and/or after games in or around the facility shall be removed from the facility/property for the duration of the tournament. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 4.) Hockey Canada rules (at minimum) will be in effect during tournament play.
- 5.) The first team listed is the HOME team and will be identified as such on the schedule.
- 6.) Any player receiving **THREE (3) PENALTIES** in one game will receive a game ejection penalty - NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 7.) Any player who receives a misconduct or game misconduct penalty in the last 10 minutes of a game will be required to sit out the next game. In all other cases, Hockey Canada rules apply.

8.) Given arena time constraints, time management policies will be strictly enforced.

9.) Each team will be permitted to have a 2-minute pre-game warmup. PLEASE HAVE YOUR TEAM ready 10 minutes prior to the start of your ice time (*we may start games early*).

10.) All GAMES will be 60 minutes in length. The 60-minute games will be structured as follows: one (1) 12 minute stop time period and two (2) 15 minute stop time periods. When 5 minutes are remaining in the time slot, at the first stoppage of play the timekeeper will alert the referee and the clock will be reset to 2 minutes of stoppage time.

11.) Game Officials will be supplied throughout the 2023 Give 'N Go Tournament. All decisions by referees are final. **PLEASE REMEMBER OUR GAME OFFICIALS ARE YOUNG and INEXPERIENCED.**

12.) NO PLAYER REPLACEMENT are allowed during the tournament. The only exception to this rule would be for an emergency replacement goalie. If a goalie is require they must be approved by the tournament committee before playing.

13.) Failure to follow the rules and/or format of the tournament may result in forfeiting the game. To be fair to all players and teams participating, please ensure the rules are read to prevent disputes during the 2023 Give N Go Tournament.

14.) Each team is responsible for providing ONE (1) Off-Ice Game Officials for the 2023 Give 'N Go Tournament. All scoresheets will be provided by the tournament committee.

15.) Dressing rooms are to be left clean after each game. Attack Sports Inc. is not responsible for lost, damaged, or stolen property.

16.) In round-robin play, there will be NO sudden death overtime or shootouts. Standings in round-robin play will be based on the following points system:

- 5 points for a win by 2 or more goals
- 4 points for a win by 1 goal
- 3 points for a tie
- 1 point for a loss by 1 goal
- 0 points for a loss by 2 or more goals

17.) Round-Robin tie-breaker formula:

- The winner of the game played between the tied teams will determine the winner.
- If the teams tied each other, the team with the highest goals for/goals against differential will determine the winner.
- If the teams tied each other, share the same differential, then the team with the lowest penalty minutes in the round-robin will be determined the winner.
- If the teams are still tied, a coin toss will determine the winner

18.) Playoff Sudden Death - if the game is tied after regulation time, a 3 player (per team) shootout will decide the game. If extra shooters are required, due to a shootout tie, a sudden death one player shootout will determine the winner (and will repeat until a winner is determined). An individual player can only participate ONCE in the shootout. The goalie that played the game must continue to play in goal in the shootout.
